Aamir to hoist the Indian National Flag in Melbourne

n a symbolic moment of cultural celebration, Aamir Khan will hoist the Indian national flag at the 16th Indian Film Festival of Melbourne (IFFM) 2025 in August. The prestigious ceremony will take place as part of the festival's annual Independence Day celebrations, a tradition that honours India's spirit and its vibrant global cultural influence.
